Caravanserai, a Persian word, describes a resting place on trading routes where merchants would stop to water camels, on the edge of cities, washing, eating and sleeping before going into town to sell their wares. With this context in mind, local architects - the pre-eminent Charles Boccara, son Mathieu and partner Max Lawrence - have created something that feels fresh, original, full of mystique.

Rooms surround a series of interconnected courtyards, interspersed with pretty pools of water, windows look inwards. Roof terraces jostle for the view. It is serene, a mule's bray muted by the metre-thick, pink pisé walls. It is rustic, without compromising comfort, featuring polished, pale ochre 'tadlakt' (polished plaster) floors, herringbone ceilings fashioned out of eucalyptus, vaulted domes, high walls, sculptural arches.
