In keeping with our commitment to the local community, all our invoices will incur a 5% charge to the Village Association "Association des Bassins d'Imlil" - a Moroccan NGO - which covers the whole of the surrounding valleys. This association provides the ambulance that you see in Imlil which provides a service to the local population and visitors, other community projects that have been undertaken include the rubbish clearance system and the provision of the village Hammam (public baths) and dormitory accommodation for children attending the secondary school in Asni.

Out of respect for Muslim traditions, The Kasbah is not licensed for alcohol.

Guests staying at the Kasbah are welcome to bring their own.

Our Azzaden Trekking Lodge



**The Azzaden Trekking Lodge is in the Azzaden Valley, a 4 hour walk from the Kasbah.
It offers 4 en suite bedrooms all with bath. There is a shared lounge and terrace. This is a new concept in trekking in the high Atlas.**

The prices do NOT include the trekking to and from the Lodge which will be needed. A minimum of a half day trek will be required each way although a full day is more comfortable and recommended. See the Trekking prices below Trekking to and from the Lodge (each way) is approximately 4 to 6 hours, depending on the route taken. Including a picnic lunch in the countryside, € 75 Euro per person per day. Half day trek per person € 27 Euro.

Dar Imlil – Riad Imlil Village



Dar Imlil may not quite have the location of the Kasbah but it is wonderfully situated on the outskirts of Imlil village near the river and looks up to The Kasbah and The Toubkal summit. It is about a 10 minute walk (500 meters) from the Kasbah and 5 minutes from the centre of Imlil.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING EXCURSIONS, TREKS, MEALS ETC BOOKED LOCALLY AT KASBAH DU TOUBKAL, MOROCCO

Please note that all excursions/trekking/guided walks that are not pre-booked and paid to Discover Ltd. in the UK but are booked locally at Kasbah du Toubkal, Imlil, Morocco, are booked with the Moroccan company Kasbah du Toubkal SARL and/or Mountain Voyage SARL. **Discover Ltd. is not a party** to these ‘Extras’ that are booked locally at Kasbah du Toubkal and/or Dar Imlil (‘Extras’: Excursions, Treks, Guided Walks, Meals etc). The contract for these locally booked services is between the client and the Moroccan organisations and come under Moroccan law.

We would also like to draw your attention to our generic risk assessments which you will find in the rooms or ask at reception. We hope you find these risk assessments useful, they are not an exhaustive list. It is your responsibility to decide if you want to do a particular activity and you should be aware that walking and mule riding in a mountainous area such as the High Atlas is likely to have a greater element of risk than these activities on the flat. These excursions are run by the Moroccan companies named above and are run under local normal practices. Clients should note that protective head gear is not provided and that the terrain is rocky and steep in many places. Clients in booking any excursions accept the risks that are involved in such activities and understand that Moroccan standard practices and local people are involved in providing these activities and the equipment provided will be that used locally. Typically these would be of a lower standard than one would expect in a developed country such as Europe, N. America etc . In participating in such excursions you accept these inherent risks.
